
2020-2021 Arrival & Dismissal Procedures

Masks will be worn at all times when 6 feet distance cannot be met.




Safety Precautions

Bus & Daycare



Bus Riders & Day Care Bus Riders will remain in the gym until 7:45 am, when they will be escorted to their classrooms.

Bus Riders and Day Care Bus Riders who need to eat breakfast will stay in the gym until a space in the cafeteria becomes available. Student walkers and bike riders will enter through the gym.


General Information:

Dismissal of students from the building begins at 3:20 pm.

Mode of Dismissal	Expectations		
K - 4th Grade Car Riders Enter Gates off Deer Meadow for Pick up at Gym Doors (3:25 pm - 3:45 pm)	 Car Riders should be picked up in front of the gym. Enter the blacktop and circle around to the gym parking lot. Note: The number of students in the gym needs to be closely monitored; therefore, car riders will remain in their classroom until parent/guardian arrives on campus. Once a parent is in line, their child's name will be entered into a document that is displayed in the classroom. Your child will then be escorted down to the gym to be picked up. 		
Bus Riders Front Circle Drive (3:20 pm - 3:45 pm)	 Bus Riders will remain in their classroom until their bus is called over the announcements. They will be escorted to their bus. 		
Walkers/Bike Riders/Day Care Gym Doors (3:20 pm)	 Student walkers and bike riders will exit through the gym and be escorted their appropriate crosswalk. Parents/Guardians are to remain on the side of the street opposite the school or behind the clearly marked cones. Parents/Guardians are not permitted to wait for their walkers/bike riders on campus. Student DayCare riders will be escorted to their appropriate DayCare bu DayCare buses will pick up students on the side of the Cafeteria. 		
ALE/Pre-K/Special Needs Front Circle Drive (3:20 pm - 3:45 pm)	 Staff will be present to assist students. Parents should notify teachers when they arrive so students can be brought out to them.
